The existing Veeder Root (Electronic Line Leak Detector) PLLD indicated a 3.0gph line failure and shut down the STP. A helium test was conducted on the product line from all dispensers to the ball valve on the STP. Helium test performed by others did not show any leak. Upon further investigation from the ball valve to the head of the STP, the line showed signs of heavy chemical (road salt) corrosion and was replaced with new sch. 40 steel pipe. The flexible connector was also replaced and installed in a sealed boot since an excavation was made and the flexible connector was fully exposed.				

A Petro Tite Line test was performed on all piping included past the ball valve with passing results.

Line testing completed on March 14th with UST Modification Report submitted on the same day. Tank system 003 "Super Unleaded" was then put back into service.

Attched is a site drawing showing the layout of the tank systems which was also supplied with the UST Modification Report. Separate phase gasoline was identified in monitoring well MW-3 on 3/25/2019 during quarterly groundwater monitoring/sampling activities associated with the 2017 release. Additional separate phase gasoline was discovered in tank field recovery wells RW-1 and RW-2 on 3/26/2019. No separate phase gasoline has been identified in any other monitoring well. Refer to the attached 11"x17" Site map for well locations.

A claim associated with this release has been submitted to PAUSTIF and interim remedial activities were intiated on 3/28/2019 for the recovery of separate phase liquids (product bailing). Interim remedial activities are ongoing and will continue as long as separate phase gasoline is present, during site characterization activities.
