Dear Ms. Lorenzetti:

The Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) has reviewed the May 12, 2020 document titled Abbreviated Site Characterization Report document for the release incident referenced above. This document was prepared by LaBella Associates, P.C., submitted as an Abbreviated Site Characterization Report and reviewed as a Site Characterization Report (SCR) under 25 Pa. Code § 245.310(b), which indicates that soil is the only media of concern and which contains data that the interim remedial actions have attained the residential Statewide health standard in accordance with 25 Pa. Code Chapter 250.

In accordance with 25 Pa. Code § 245.310(c)(1), DEP approves the SCR for the substances identified and remediated. Chapter 5, Section 501 of Act 2, provides the liability protection where attainment of Act 2 cleanup standards is demonstrated. The cleanup liability protection provided by this chapter applies to the current and future owner or any other person who participated in the remediation; a person who develops or occupies the property; successor or assign of any person to whom liability protection applies; and a public utility to the extent the public utility performs activities on the identified property.

Any person aggrieved by this action may appeal the action to the Environmental Hearing Board (Board) pursuant to Section 4 of the Environmental Hearing Board Act, 35 P.S. § 7514, and the Administrative Agency Law, 2 Pa.C.S. Chapter 5A. The Board's address is:
