The Department of Environmental Protection (Department) has reviewed the document titled Amended Site Characterization Report, dated April 2020, for the release referenced above. The document was prepared by McKee Environmental, Inc. and submitted as a Site Characterization Report (SCR) as required by 25 Pa. Code § 245.310. You selected the Site Specific Standard (SSS) for soil and the Used Aquifer Residential Statewide Health Standard (SHS) as the remediation standard for groundwater.

The Department approves the SCR in accordance with 25 Pa. Code § 245.310(c)(1).

- You state that you plan to attain the SHS for groundwater. Please be aware that the SHS is not available to you currently since impacts exceed the SHS at and beyond the point of compliance (POC). Be aware that you should pursue active on and off-site remediation in order to attain the SHS or choose the SSS.

25 Pa. Code § 245.311 requires that a Remedial Action Plan (RAP) be submitted within 45 days of approval of the SCR. Failure to submit a RAP by that date may result in enforcement action by the Department.

Any person aggrieved by this action may appeal the action to the Environmental Hearing Board (Board) pursuant to Section 4 of the Environmental Hearing Board Act, 35 P.S. § 7514, and the Administrative Agency Law, 2 Pa.C.S. Chapter 5A. The Board's address is:

Appeals must be filed with the Board within 30 days of receipt of notice of this action unless the appropriate statute provides a different time. This paragraph does not, in and of itself, create any right of appeal beyond that permitted by applicable statutes and decisional law.

IF YOU WANT TO CHALLENGE THIS ACTION, YOUR APPEAL MUST BE FILED WITH AND RECEIVED BY THE BOARD WITHIN 30 DAYS OF RECEIPT OF NOTICE OF THIS ACTION.
